IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED and DECREED as follows:
The Plaintiff's Motion for Partial Summary Judgment is GRANTED in part and DENIED
in part.
Because a genuine issue of material fact does not exist regarding Defendant's violation of
the Declaration, the Plaintiff is entitled to a partial summary judgment as follows: the Defendant
is in violation of the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions, and Restrictions for the Lacamas
Shores Development by failing to maintain the storm drainage and treatment system located on
the Defendant's property.

The Plaintiff failed to demonstrate the absence of a genuine issue of material fact regarding the nuisance per se claims and, therefore, the Plaintiff's motion for partial summary judgment regarding those claims is DENIED.
